

# Public Invited To Ambassador New Year's Eve

## Brand New Building Offers 26 x 60 Floor With Good Entertainment

One of the highlights of New Year's Eve in Anchorage will be the grand opening of the Ambassador Club, a modern night club at Sixth and C Streets, with accommodations for 200 persons and a fine program of entertainment.

Under the management of Sam Kinsler, veteran night club operator in Anchorage, the Ambassador Club will bring to local residents one of the finest entertainment centers in Alaska, in modernistic surroundings that would do credit to many cities in the states.

The new building, designed and erected for the Ambassador Club, is furnished delightfully with 23 booths and in addition tables with comfortable tubular chairs.

A dance floor measuring 26 by 60 feet is available for patrons, with the booths surrounding it. One of the longest bars in Anchorage, measuring 28 feet, has been installed to furnish speedy and efficient service.

The club is lighted by the indirect method, with modernistic metal Luminaire fixtures reflecting the light against the ceiling. Special attention has been given the ventilation. The club has 43 small windows to keep the air circulating without causing drafts. The ceiling is attractively finished in white and green and is 18 feet from the floor.

The orchestra will be in a special pit at one end of the club, separated from the dance floor. Betty Woods will be the pianist and a public address system will carry the voices of entertainers to the most distant corners.

Reservations are being made for the opening night and already the house is nearly sold out.
