Beverly June Finley, 23, had been arrested at the Leprechaun Room about 8:30 p.m. Friday after police officers said she was dancing nude from the waist up.


Cathy M. Blocker, 25, was arrested by police about 1:30 a.m. Saturday at the Flame Lounge under similar circumstances.
